Goals of the project

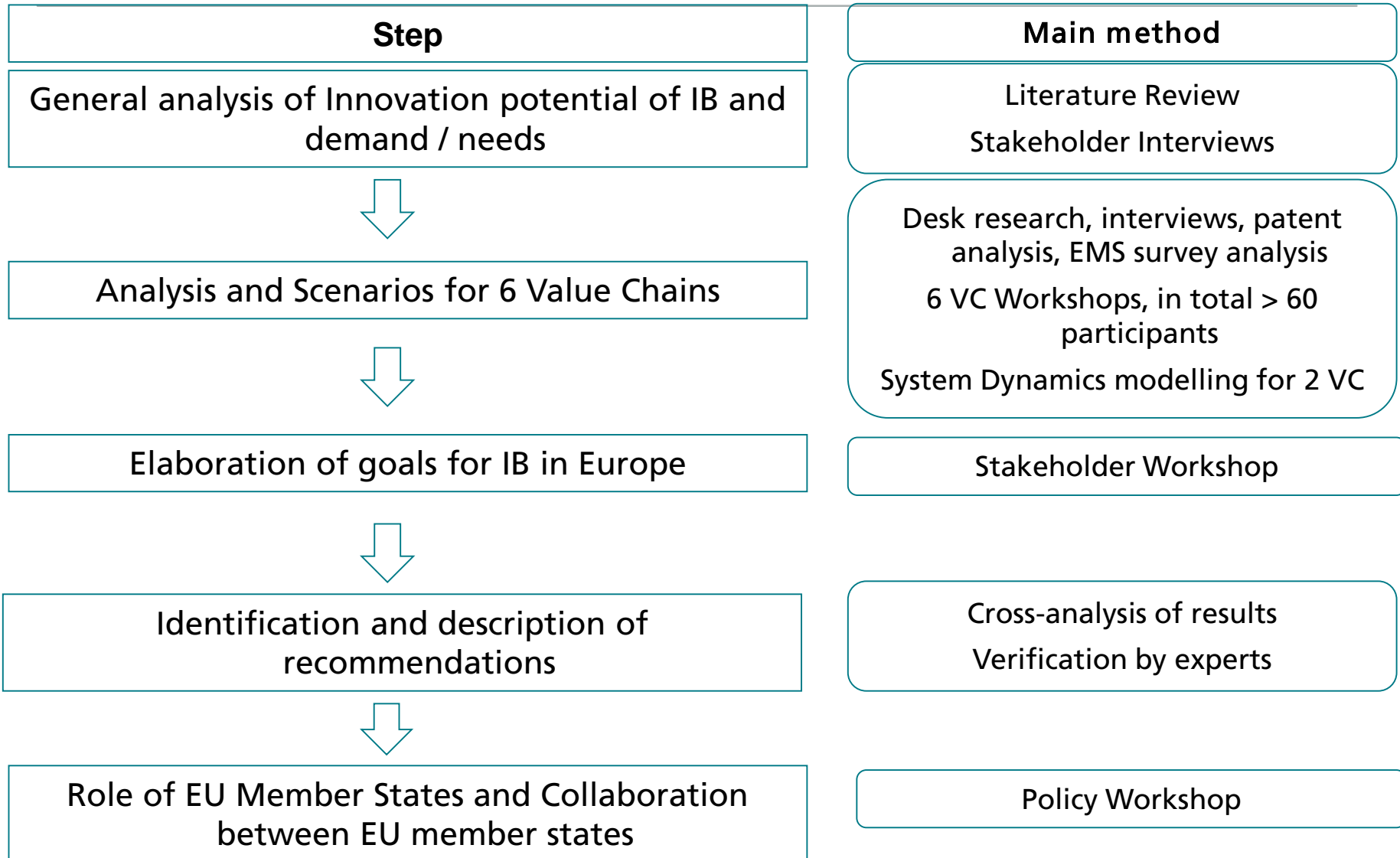
Main Goal
